Talk to examine Upstate's economy

While a slew of business announcements promise new jobs in the region, reports of more businesses shuttering their doors still plague the Upstate in what has been termed the "new recovery" following the Great Recession.

Now the three Golden Strip cities of Fountain Inn, Mauldin and Simpsonville

have collaborated to bring in Dr. Donald Schunk, a research economist at the BB&T Center for Economic and Community Development at Coastal Carolina University in an attempt to answer questions on how the Upstate and state may change with this "new recovery."
